

WARMTH FOR ALL FUNDRAISER for children in Gaza ... Winter is coming.

On behalf of the children of Gaza, many of whom live in extreme poverty and without access to life-saving medical treatments and basic necessities for normal development and good health, please contribute to a fundraising effort led by **Dr. Jihad Hasanain** and supported by the US-based **Scout Fuller Fund for Social Justice** and **Maine Voices for Palestinian Rights (MVPR)**.

The project, **WARMTH FOR ALL**, will help provide winter protection such as warm clothing, blankets, roof/shelter repair, food, medicines, and other needed items for children's health and well-being.

About Dr. Jihad Hasanain:

Dr Jihad Hasanain is a physician affiliated with Al-Shifa Hospital in Gaza who dedicates his life to providing medical care and advocating for children in need so as to alleviate their suffering.

Dr Hasanain was recently a speaker at a conference held by the Palestinian Ministry of Health with the support of MAP-UK (Medical Aid for Palestinians). He addressed the challenges* facing cancer patients (and the doctors who provide their care), and ways to overcome these challenges so that adequate treatment can be provided.

**Statistics show a marked increase in the number of cancer patients in Gaza. Unfortunately, early detection is made difficult because of the lack of diagnostic devices, tests, and labs. And most of the medicines needed for treatment, especially cancers that affect children, are not available. Also, neither chemotherapy nor radiotherapy -- the cornerstone of treatment -- is available, AND patients are not allowed to receive treatment outside Gaza.*

Except for FB processing fees, all money donated to Warmth for All goes directly to helping the children, with no administrative or overhead expenses whatsoever.

About the Scout Fuller Fund for Social Justice:

The Scout Fuller Fund for Social Justice supports individuals and organizations who, in the spirit of Scout Fuller's concern for others and sense of justice, are working to improve the lives of others.

Josephine 'Scout' Fuller was eight years old when she passed away following her struggle with cancer. Throughout her brief but caring life, Scout was a strong voice for peace and justice in her school and community. She was wise beyond her years and deeply concerned for the needy of the world.
